

HEALTH CARE AND GUIDELINES FOR CATS AND DOGS BEFORE AND AFTER THE SURGERY

- Pet's should be healthy (1) one week prior to surgery.
- Required age for cats is 4months old and above, and atleast 2.5 kg in weight, for dogs 6 months old and above.
- Blood test, is suggested before the surgery to reduce the risk and complications.
- It is recommended that your pet is fully vaccinated before the surgery.
- · Cats should be in secured cage, and dogs should be in leash.
- Fasting (NO FOOD, NO WATER) for atleast 6-8 HOURS.
- Mother cats/dogs that have or just given birth, you should wait atleast 1 to 2 months after she gave birth.
- Your pet have undergo anesthesia let it rest to recover, allow
 3-4 hours to pass before giving moderate food and water.
- DO NOT let your pet jump, run and play for (1) one week to prevent dehiscene of wound.
- DO NOT bathe for (1) week, use E-collar to prevent licking, bitting and scratching of wound.
- Your cat will have an ear notch/tattoo as a universal markings that it is already neutered.
- Be sure to follow and give the prescribed medications to avoid any infection, the medication will be given after 1 day.
